

ORDINANCE NO. 11

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING GENERAL PROVISIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN OF THE CITY OF HUNTER:

SECTION 1. The provisions, regulations and requirements of these ordinances shall have effect and be in force, and shall extend and apply to all persons, objects, things and subjects within the corporate limits of the city of Hunter; provided, that the ordinance concerning the board of health and all provisions relating to the sanitary matters shall, in addition to such limits, have effect and be in force and shall extend and apply to all persons, objects, things and subjects within five miles of the limits of the city.

SECTION 2. Whenever in these ordinances words importing the plura number are used in describing or referring to any objects, matters, party or persons, any single object, matter, party or person shall be deemed in eluded.

SECTION 3. All words in this ordinances importing the singular or masculine gender shall be deemed to include and be applicable to several subjects, matters, parties and persons, females as well as males, bodies corporate and co-partnership as well as individuals, when such construction is not clearly in conflict with the intent of the section in which such words occur.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city paper.
