

ORDINANCE NO. 12

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATING AND MOVING OF TRACTION AND PORTABLE ENGINES AND HEAVY MACHINERY OR VEHICLES OF ANY KIND OVER AND ALONG THE BRIDGES, STREETS, AND ALLEYS OF THE CITY OF HUNTER, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN OF THE CITY OF HUNTER, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person owning, controlling, operating or managing any steam traction, gas traction, or portable engine of any kind, or heavy show wagons or other vehicles liable to cause injury, to move the same over or along any of the bridges, streets or alleys of the City of Hunter, Kansas, without first placing on all bridges, culverts and cross walks planks at least one foot wide, three inches in thickness and of sufficient length while crossing the same for the wheels of such engine or vehicle to run on while crossing such bridge, culvert or cross walks.

SECTION 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined in a sum not less than \$2.00 or more than \$25.00.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city paper.
