ORDINANCE NO. 15

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING THE STANDARD OIL CO. (INDIANA) PERMISSION TO ERECT BUILDINGS AND TANKS FOR THE STORAGE OF PETROLEUM PRODUCTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN OF THE CITY OF HUNTER, KANSAS IN THE COUNTY OF MITCHELL, STATE OF KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That permission and authority is hereby given and granted to the Standard Oil Co. a Corporation organized and doing business under and by virtue of the laws of the state of Indiana, to construct and maintain, for a period of (20) twenty years in the following described property to which Lots 13-14-15. Block 7. Wagner Additions to Hunter, Kansas.

Necessary for its business and to store therein illuminating oils, coal oil, naphtha, gasoline or any other mineral oils or fluids, the product of petroleum in quantities sufficient to meet the requirements of its said business.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and acceptance in writing by said Standard Oil Co.
