ORDINANCE NO. 16

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE LIMITS OF KEEPING JACKS, STALLIONS OR BULLS IN THE CITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN OF THE CITY OF HUNTER:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to keep any jacks, stallions or bulls within two blocks of Gaylord street, or within two hundred feet of any residence, except it be the owner thereof, in the city of Hunter, Mitchell county, Kansas.

SECTION 2. That the violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor and upon conviction be punished by a fine not to exceed (\$50.00) Fifty Dollars.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect on and after its publication in the Hunter Herald.
