

ORDINANCE NO. 22

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS OF THE CITY OF HUNTER IN THE SUM OF FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$15,000) FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING AND EXTENDING WORKS FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUPPLYING THE CITY OF HUNTER AND ITS INHABITANTS WITH ELECTRIC LIGHTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN OF THE CITY OF HUNTER:

SECTION 1. Under the authority of the special bond election held in Hunter, Kansas, on November 5, 1919, when such bonds were duly and legally voted, the bonds of the City of Hunter are hereby directed to be issued by the proper officers of the City of Hunter, Kansas, in the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) for the purpose of constructing and extending works for the supplying of the City of Hunter and its inhabitants with electric lights.

SECTION 2. Said bonds when issued shall be in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) each, and shall bear interest at the rate of five and one-half percent per annum.

SECTION 3. Said bonds shall mature at twenty years from the date thereof.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official city paper.
