ORDINANCE NO. 24

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RATES FOR ELECTRIC CURRENT, FOR THE USE OF LIGHT POWER AND HEAT AND PRESCRIBING THE RULES AND REGULATIONS THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN OF THE CITY OF HUNTER, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the following rates for electric current for light and heat shall be:

- 18c per K W hrs. for K W hrs, 1 to 20
- 15c per K W hrs. for K W hrs, 20 to 40
- 12c per K W hours thereafter used in any one month.

The minimum for any one month shall be \$1.50.

SECTION 2. The rates for electric current used for power shall be 12c per K W hr. The minimum for any one month shall be \$1.00.

SECTION 3. When any party wishes electric current he shall make a deposit of \$10.00 with the city clerk for a meter the amount to be returned when the party disconnects and returns the meter in good shape. Or a fee of 25 cents per month shall be charged for the use of meter if deposit is not made, the same to be paid with electric light bill.

SECTION 4. The fee for connecting line and installing meter shall be \$2.00.

SECTION 5. That all meters shall be sealed by the city. No meter shall be removed, repaired or the seal broken, except by authority of the city under penalty of having the current cut off.

SECTION 6. The city reserves the right at all times, without notice, to cut off the current for the purpose of making extensions or repairing the line, and no claims shall be allowed for it by the city. It is further stipulated that the City of Hunter does not guarantee uninterrupted service, except when its equipment is in good working order.

SECTION 7. That all accounts for electric current shall be due and payable at the office of the City Clerk in Hunter, Kansas, on the second day of each month, and must be paid by the 10th of each month.

Any person or consumer who shall fail or refuse to pay their account as herein set forth, their service shall be cut off and shall not be connected until the account is paid in full and a fee of \$1.00 is paid for connecting the same.

SECTION 8. That this ordinance be in full force and effect from and after its publication in the Hunter Herald.
