ORDINANCE NO. 25

AN ORDINANCE CALLING AN ELECTION FOR THE CITY OF HUNTER, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN OF THE CITY OF HUNTER:

SECTION 1. That on Monday, April 4, 1921, at the Directors room in the Farmers State Bank in said city of Hunter, Kansas, an election shall be held for the purpose of electing city officers. At which election a Mayor, a Police Judge, and Five Councilmen shall be elected.

SECTION 2. That E. C. Thompson, W. F. Dunckley and B. B. Rounkles shall act as Judges and Roy E. Briney and M. D. Cunningham shall act as Clerks of said election.

SECTION 3. That the polls shall be open from 8 a. m. until 6 p. m.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city paper.
