

## ORDINANCE NO. 34

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL LEVY OF TAXES IN THE CITY OF HUNTER, KANSAS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 1928.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN OF THE CITY OF HUNTER, KANSAS:

### GENERAL REVENUE FUND

SECTION 1. That there be and hereby is levied upon all taxable property within the city of Hunter, Kansas, a tax of (1) one mill on a dollar of the assessed valuation of said taxable property for general purposes.

### INTEREST FUND

SECTION 2. That there be and hereby is levied upon all taxable property within said city a tax of (3  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) three and one-quarter mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of said taxable property for interest purposes.

### BOND SINKING FUND

SECTION 3. That there be and hereby is levied upon all taxable property within said city, a tax of (4  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) four and one-quarter mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of said taxable property for bond sinking purposes.

### LIGHT FUND

SECTION 4. That there be and hereby is levied upon all taxable property within said city, a tax of (1) one mill on the dollar of the assessed valuation of said taxable property for lighting purposes.

### STREET AND ALLEY

SECTION 5. That there be and hereby is levied upon all taxable property within said city, a tax of (4) four mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of said taxable property for street and alley improvement. Making a total of (13  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) thirteen and one-half mills.

AND I HEREBY CERTIFY, pursuant to the directions and orders of the Mayor and Councilmen of the said city, and as required by law, the levies of taxes by said ordinance are made to the County Clerk of Mitchell County, Kansas, to be by him placed upon the Tax Roll as prescribed by law.
