

ORDINANCE NO. 41

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL LEVY OF TAXES IN THE CITY OF HUNTER KANSAS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 1930.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN OF THE CITY OF HUNTER, KANSAS:

State of Kansas, Mitchell County, as

I, the undersigned, City Clerk of the City of Hunter in said county, hereby certify that the following is a full and complete statement of said City, levying taxes for the year 1930-1931, that the same was duly passed August 4, 1930 and published August 8, 1930.

GENERAL REVENUE FUND

SECTION 1. That there be and hereby is levied upon all taxable property within the City of Hunter, Kansas, a tax of (2) two mills on a dollar of the assessed valuation of said taxable property for general purposes.

INTEREST FUND

SECTION 2. That there be and hereby is levied upon all taxable property within said city a tax of (3) three mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of said taxable property for interest purposes.

BOND SINKING FUND

SECTION 3. That there be and hereby is levied upon all taxable property within said city a tax of (4) four mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of said taxable property for bond sinking purposes.

STREET AND ALLEY

SECTION 5. That there be and hereby is levied upon all taxable property within said city a tax of (3) three mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of said taxable property for street and alley improvement. Making a total of (12) twelve mills.

AND I HEREBY CERTIFY, pursuant to the directions and orders of the Mayor and Councilmen of the said city, and as required by law, the levies of taxes by said ordinance are made to the County Clerk of Mitchell County, Kansas, to be by him placed upon the Tax Roll as prescribed by law.
