ORDINANCE NO. 42

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO VEHICLES AND PROVIDING TRAFFIC RULES AND REGULATIONS IN THE CITY OF HUNTER, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN OF THE CITY OF HUNTER, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The words and phrases used in this ordinance shall be construed as follows; "Motor Vehicles" shall include all vehicles propelled by any power other than muscular power. Highways shall include public streets, roads, turnpikes, parks, parkways, drives, alleys and other public ways used for passage of road vehicles.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person owning or operating any vehicle, either motor or horsedrawn, on the streets or alleys of the city of Hunter, Kansas, to park on any cross streets or intersection, or on or across any sidewalk within the corporate limits of the city of Hunter, Kansas.

SECTION 3. Muffler. Every vehicle using gasoline or other explosive mixture as a motive power shall use a muffler which shall be sufficient to deaden the sound of the explosions, and such muffler shall not be disconnected or cut-out while such vehicle is being operated on the highways of said City.

SECTION 4. Penalty. Any person violating any of the terms or provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, before the police court of said city, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00), nor less than Two Dollars (\$2.00), or imprisonment in the jail of said City for not more than Thirty (3) Days, or both fine and imprisonment and such persons so convicted shall be remanded to the jail of said City until sentence of the court is fully satisfied.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city paper.
