

ORDINANCE NO. 45

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A FRANCHISE FOR THE HUNTER TELEPHONE EXCHANGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUNTER, KANSAS:

It is hereby ordered that on and after the passage of this ordinance and the publication in the Hunter Herald the Hunter telephone exchange shall have a franchise to erect its poles upon and along the streets and alleys of the city of Hunter, Kansas, to maintain its exchange, to maintain its wires in the streets and alleys of the City of Hunter, the proper height from the street level, for a period of twenty (20) years.
