NOTICE TO LANDOWNERS AND LIENHOLDERS

To Farm Mortgage Holding Company, a Corporation, and To All Whom it May Concern:

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED, that the City of Hunter, Kansas, desiring, for the purpose of obtaining a water supply and maintaining a water supply for the use of the city of Hunter, Kansas, and of its inhabitants, to acquire in the name of the City of Hunter, a certain tract of land situated in Mitchell County, Kansas, shown by the records of said county to be land to which you hold title, or on which you have a lien, and described as follows:
