

## REVISED ORDINANCE NO. 7

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUNTER, MITCHELL COUNTY, KANSAS, THAT SECTION 8 (EIGHT) OF ARTICLE NO. 3 (THREE) OF ORDINANCE NO. 7 (SEVEN) OF THE CITY OF HUNTER, BE ANNULLED AS ORIGINALLY WRITTEN AND THAT THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS RELATING TO "HEALTH", "MISDEMEANORS" AND "SLAUGHTER HOUSES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS" BE SUBSTITUTED THEREFOR:

### SECTION 8

#### HEALTH

Said board of health or any member thereof, or the city marshal, shall have authority to prohibit the selling of any unwholesome fruit, vegetables, meat, or provisions of any and every kind or description and shall have full power to inspect any and all fruits, vegetables, meat and provisions of any and all kids, for the purpose of ascertaining if the same be wholesome.

Provided that any meat, fruit or vegetables stored or kept for sale in a building in which any part of the same is used for an unwholesome business or where the surroundings are not sanitary the said board of health shall have full power to condemn all fruit, vegetables or meat kept or exhibited for sale in said building.

Providing further that the slaughtering, skinning or removing the entrails of any animal shall constitute an unsanitary condition if done within a building, part of which is used for the storing and displaying of fruits, vegetables or meat.

#### MISDEMEANORS

No person shall haul or cause to be hauled through the streets of said city at any hour, day or night, any dead animal exposed to public view or which shall be bleeding or otherwise offensive, provided however that this ordinance does not apply to the removing of a carcass from the city limits for the purpose of burial. Any person violating the provision for this section, shall. Upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not less than one dollar nor more than twenty-five dollars.

#### SLAUGHTER HOUSE WITHIN CITY LIMITS

No person shall own, operate or maintain any place within the city limits wherein hogs, cattle, sheep of any age or description, shall be killed or disemboweled or where any part of the entrails or skin of any said animals shall be removed. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not less than ten dollars, nor more than one hundred dollars.

This amendment shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication once in the Hunter Herald of Hunter, Kansas the official paper of the said Hunter, Kansas.
