

ORDINANCE NO. 66

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING REVENUE FOR THE CITY OF HUNTER, KANSAS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1939.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HUNTER, KANSAS.

SECTION 1. That for the purpose of raising revenue to defray the current expenses of the City of Hunter, Kansas, for the year 1939. There be and are hereby levied upon all taxable property (except when otherwise taxed as provided by law) within the City of Hunter, Kansas, taxes as follows: for the purpose indicated, such taxes being represented by mills and fraction of mills on the dollar.

General Fund ----- .0024

Street and Alley Fund ----- .002

Water Fund ----- .0006

Light Fund ----- .0016

SECTION 2. That the City Clerk of the city of Hunter, Kansas is hereby directed to certify the foregoing tax levy and special assessments to the County Clerk of Mitchell County, Kansas, on or before August 25, 1938 to be placed on the tax rolls for the year 1938 for collections as provided by law.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after one publication in the Hunter Herald.
