

ORDINANCE NO. 68

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING REVENUE FOR THE CITY OF HUNTER, KANSAS, FOR THE BUDGET YEAR, 1941.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HUNTER, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That for the purpose of raising revenue to defray the current expenses of the City of Hunter, Kansas, as required by the Budget for the calendar year 1941, as heretofore adopted and in compliance therewith, there be and are hereby levied upon all taxable property, (except when otherwise taxed as provided by law,) within the City of Hunter, Kansas, taxes as follows on each dollar assessed valuation, for the purpose indicated by mill and fractions of mills.

General Fund ----- .00091 mills  
Street and Alley Fund ----- .0018 mills  
Street Light Fund ----- .00025 mills  
Water Fund ----- .00048 mills  
Band Fund ----- .00000 mills

SECTION 2. The City Clerk of Hunter, Kansas, is directed to certify the foregoing tax levies to the County Clerk of Mitchell County, Kansas, on or before August 25, 1940, to be placed on the tax rolls for the year 1940 for collection as provided by law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Hunter Herald, Hunter, Kansas.
