

ORDINANCE NO. 78

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULAR CITY ELECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN OF THE CITY OF HUNTER,  
MITCHELL COUNTY, KANSAS.

SECTION 1. That the regular city election of the city of Hunter, Kansas, shall be held on Tuesday, April 1st, 1947, from the hours of 8:00 o'clock A. M. to 6:00 o'clock P. M. in the City Hall in the City of Hunter, Kansas, for the purpose of electing a mayor, police judge and five (5) councilmen.

SECTION 2. That Nelson Bruce, Ed Anderson and Horace Farr are hereby designated by the Mayor with the approval of the Council, to act as judges of said election: That Mrs. Florence Leonhart, and Mrs. Nellie Rounkles are hereby designated by the Mayor and approved by the Council to act as Clerk of said election.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force after publication in five business places in said city, Hunter, Kansas there being no Town Newspaper for publishing same in.
