

ORDINANCE NO. 114

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULAR CITY ELECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN OF THE CITY OF HUNTER,  
MITCHELL COUNTY, KANSAS.

SECTION 1. That the regular city election of the City of Hunter, Kansas, shall be held on Tuesday, April 2, 1963, from the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall in the city of Hunter, Kansas, for the purpose of electing a mayor, police judge and five councilmen.

SECTION 2. That Vida Standley, Lucille Schulz, Murich Thurston are hereby designated by the mayor with the approval of the council to act as judges of said election and Blanche Schneider, Matilda Thomas are hereby designated by the mayor and approved by the council to act as clerks of said election.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.
