ORDINANCE NO. 135

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE FOR THE CITY OF HUNTER A WATER SUPPLY CONTRACT WITH RURAL WATER DISTRICT NO. 2, MITCHELL COUNTY, KANSAS.

Whereas, said District has been organized and established under the provisions of KSA 82a-612 et seq., for the purpose of building and operating a water distribution system serving water users within the boundaries of the District, and

Whereas, the City of Hunter is located within the boundaries of said District and owns and operates a water distribution system and it is deemed expedient by the governing body to purchase water from said District for distribution by the City to its customers, and

Whereas, the Water Supply Contract negotiated by and between said Water District and the City of Hunter, is considered equitable, fair and favorable to the welfare and future needs of the City,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HUNTER, KANSAS,

SECTION 1. That the Water Supply Contract proposed to the City of Hunter, by Rural Water District No. 2, Mitchell County, Kansas, be accepted and approved.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Hunter be authorized and directed to execute said Water Supply Contract for and on behalf of the City of Hunter, Kansas.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in the official City paper.
