

RESOLUTION NO. 156

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Hunter, Kansas being the mayor and City Council, is authorized to adopt a user charge rate schedule pertaining to the sewage disposal plant and sewer system of the City of Hunter, Kansas as provided in Article V, Section 5, of Ordinance Number 152; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to establish said rate schedule because service to users shall commence in a short period of time;

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the monthly sewer rates to be charged and collected for the use of and service rendered by the sewage disposal plant and sewer system of the City (such plant and system shall mean and include all means by which sewage is transported, treated and disposed of in and by the City's sewage treatment plant system and facilities) to all customers and users of such plant and system, including all persons, city departments, the United States, this State, all subdivisions of such State, and all institutions, organizations and others whose premises are connected, or may hereafter be connected, directly or indirectly, to the City's sanitary sewage treatment plant and system shall be as follows:

For each residence or residential dwelling unit and each customer, whether person, firm or corporation, having any waters or waste having less than (1) a 5-day BOD greater than 300 parts per million by weight, or (2) containing more than 350 parts per million by weight of suspended solids, or (3) having an average daily flow greater than 2 percent of the average sewage flow of the City, the sewer rate or fee shall be \$4.00 per month.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for each commercial, industrial or other customer having a sewer connection directly or indirectly with the City's sewage treatment plant and system, and discharging into such sewage treatment plant and system waters or wastes in excess of the limitations and amounts as above provided shall be responsible for and shall pay a monthly sewer rate and fee which shall be in multiples of the rate as hereinabove provided in the preceding paragraph and in such amounts as may be fixed from time to time by the governing body of the City, taking into consideration the sewage burden aforesaid.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no sanitary sewer service shall be furnished or rendered by the sewage treatment plant and system free of charge.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution be published once in the official City paper.
