The Hunter City Council was called to order by the Council President Chad Hauser @ 7:00 pm. The council members Ashley Schneider, Dixie Sloggett, Joyce Schneider and Brian Christianson were present. Also in attendance was Laura Pahls and Serrina Schneider

Minutes were read— Ashley Schneider made a motion to approve the minutes as read. Brian Christianson 2nd. Motion carried.

Bills were read - - Ashley Schneider made a motion to pay the bills as presented. Brian Christianson 2nd, motion carried.

Water report—Have 2 on the late water list. The water loss for the month was 46,000. We had the tower wash-out, this contributed to water loss. Water line at the park is fixed and the restrooms are open for business.

Community room report -\$550.00 - May and \$250.00 for June was reported. The insurance letter is ready to be delivered to the Hunter Economic Development Group for their 2/3 share. It is \$3,648.66 this year. They have filled out one application for on premises cereal malt beverage license. Discussion was had. The clerk stated she did the background check and all is clear. Ashley Schnieder made a motion to approve the license as presented. Joyce Schnieder seconded. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report— Budget is at 55%, Serrina has renewed the CD at 4.41%. Working on the Budget with Carolyn Brock in Beloit July 15.

Dream Big 2.0 update: Discussion was had pertaining to the Storage Room to be added onto the community building. The committee would like to spend all the Dream Big money (\$10,000) on this one project. They need the city council's approval. Ashley Schneider made the motion to put all \$10,000 towards the

storage room addition at the back of the community center. Joyce Schneider 2nd. Motion carried.

The clerk has contacted the Chad Carter that had installed the cameras at city hall for a quote to see about installing a camera at the city lot equipment barn.

Ruth Roberts - was wondering why the city website was not up to date with meeting minutes. Laura stated that she was behind on getting the minutes on there and she would get that taken care of. Ruth also commented about the trimming and mowing at the mural park and weeds in the sidewalks. She had pulled them.
